

Disability Support Services

Disability Services:

- Theory class tests are not timed, individuals who need more time will have the time needed to complete the test.
- Individuals who need to take a test in a quiet room will have access to an adequately private room.
- Individuals who require a test to be read to them will have access to a staff member to help read the test.
- Individuals who require a modified test will have access to a modified version.
- Individuals who request Reasonable Accommodations will need to supply The Institute with proper support documents.
- Accessibility for disabled persons include, but are not limited to, restrooms, building entrance/exits, classrooms, styling areas and administrative offices.

Request for Reasonable Accommodations:

- The Institute's Admissions Director has been designated to handle inquiries regarding non-discrimination policies and services for disabilities, including intellectual disabilities.
- Individuals with disabilities are afforded an equal opportunity to participate in The Institute's programs and activities, along with equal employment opportunities in the industry, but note that The Institute and future potential employers may only be required to make reasonable modifications or accommodations for such individuals, as required by law.
